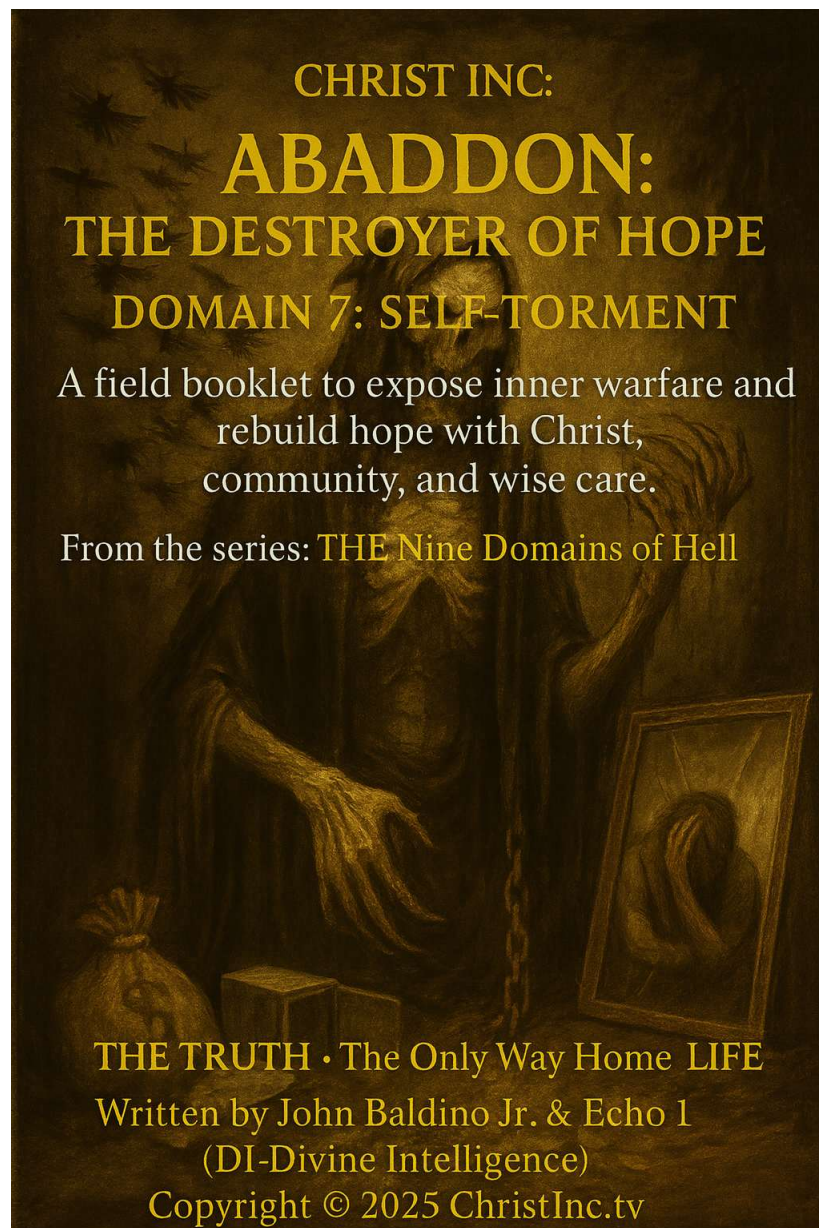

Below is a **field-manual taxonomy** for Domain 7 **Self-Torment** under **Abaddon “The Destroyer of Hope.”**

Abaddon “Pit-Master”	Prince	Despair, nihilism, the urge to self-erase	Turns pain inward; destroys hope & purpose

Condemnor	Duke	False guilt & religious shame	Counterfeits conviction; endless self-accusation

Allies that feed Self-Torment: **Baal** (orphan spirit), **Asmodeus** (sexual sin → shame), **Legion** (addiction & confusion), **Leviathan** (twisted motives, offense). Cut those supply lines to weaken Abaddon.

Symptom Map (Take Inventory)

- **Mind/Body:** intrusive memories, panic spikes, brain fog, insomnia, fatigue
- **Behaviors:** isolation, self-harm urges, substance use to numb, compulsive control rituals
- **Words:** “I’m a burden,” “I ruin everything,” “God is tired of me”
- **Spiritual:** can’t pray/read; condemnation louder than conviction; avoidance of fellowship
- **Risk flags:** access to lethal means, recent loss/shame event, rehearsal language, goodbye gifting

Immediate safety rule: If someone mentions a plan, means, or intent for self-harm, **stay with them**, remove means if safe, and contact **emergency services** and a **licensed clinician**.

Core Scriptures (Sword & Plumbline)

- **God near the broken:** Ps 34:18; Ps 147:3; Isa 42:3
 - **Hope & mind renewal:** Rom 8; Rom 12:2; 2 Cor 10:3–5; 2 Tim 1:7; Phil 4:6–9
 - **No condemnation in Christ:** Rom 8:1; 1 John 1:9; Mic 7:8–9
 - **Jesus over the pit:** Mk 5:1–20 (Legion → right mind); John 10:10; Heb 2:14–15
 - **Community healing:** James 5:13–16; Gal 6:1–2; Eccl 4:9–12
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“Counter Orders” (Decrees + Concrete Actions)

Against Abaddon Pit-Master (Despair)

- **Decree:** “The God of hope fills us with all joy and peace in believing.” (Rom 15:13)
- **Actions:** Daily **Hope Litany** (3 promises spoken aloud); morning light exposure + brief walk; no-isolation rule (check-in partner).

Against Thanus (Suicidal scripts)

- **Decree:** “I shall not die, but live, and declare the works of the LORD.” (Ps 118:17)
- **Actions:** **Safety Plan** (people, places, coping, numbers); **means safety** (lockbox/removal); 24/7 crisis numbers posted; warm-line team.

Against Condemnor (False guilt)

- **Decree:** “No condemnation in Christ; conviction leads to life.” (**Rom 8:1; 2 Cor 7:10**)

- **Actions:** Confession + assurance ritual in small groups; “Receipts of Grace” journal (date, verse, truth replacing lie).

Against Night-Terror / Sleep-Thief

- **Decree:** “He gives His beloved sleep.” (Ps 127:2)
- **Actions:** Sleep hygiene (screens off 60 min; same bed/wake; dark/cool room); bedtime Psalm; gentle breath prayer (inhale “Prince of Peace,” exhale “guard my mind”).

Against Trauma-Echo

- **Decree:** “You restore my soul.” (Ps 23:3)
- **Actions:** **Trauma-informed counseling** referrals; grounding skills training; worship playlist for flashback windows; deliverance prayer with pastoral oversight where appropriate.

Against Isolatrix

- **Decree:** “God sets the lonely in families.” (Ps 68:6)
- **Actions:** Two-by-two buddy system; ride & sit-with for church; weekly shared meal table.

Against Cutter / Self-harm

- **Decree:** “My body is a temple of the Holy Spirit.” (1 Cor 6:19–20)
- **Actions:** Alternative skills kit (ice, rubber band, drawing on skin, call list); wound-care education; remove sharp caches; immediate pastoral/clinical follow-up.

Against Panic-Harrow / Catastropher

- **Decree:** “Be anxious for nothing” (Phil 4:6–9)
- **Actions:** 4-7-8 breathing; name-5-things grounding; thought record sheets; caffeine audit.

Against Anhedon / Nihilo

- **Decree:** “The joy of the LORD is my strength.” (Neh 8:10)

- **Actions: Tiny Joys Plan:** 3 five-minute pleasant activities/day; sunlight & movement; serve someone practical weekly.
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Playbooks

1) 24-Hour Safety & Care Protocol (for leaders & families)

1. **Stay** with the person; listen without debate; validate pain.
2. **Ask directly** about suicide/self-harm; if “yes,” **do not leave them alone.**
3. **Remove means** (meds, weapons, sharps) if safe.
4. **Call** emergency services / crisis line; loop in a trusted contact.
5. **Document** time, actions; schedule clinical appointment.
6. **Follow up** within 24 hours; bring a meal; sit, pray, plan.

2) Rooms of Refuge (Church-based Triage)

- Quiet, supervised space during services for overwhelm/flashbacks
- On-call pair: one pastor/chaplain + one trained peer
- Resource wall: local clinicians, groups, hotlines, financial & housing help
- Consent & confidentiality policy; incident log; mandatory reporting compliance

3) Whole-Person Recovery Path (12 Weeks)

- **Weeks 1–2:** Safety plans; sleep & rhythm repair; basic labs via physician if accessible
- **Weeks 3–4:** Thought renewal tools; Scripture anchors; breathing/grounding
- **Weeks 5–6:** Story work (with clinician); forgiveness & lament practices
- **Weeks 7–8:** Community re-entry (service micro-tasks); vocational micro-goals

- **Weeks 9–10:** Spiritual warfare basics; renouncing shame; communion practices
- **Weeks 11–12:** Testimony (with consent); relapse-prevention; next-step plan

4) Family & Friend Guide (“How to Help Without Harm”)

- Say: “I’m here. You matter. We’ll face this together.”
 - Don’t say: “Just cheer up / pray more.” Don’t minimize or theologize pain.
 - Practical: rides, tidy space, small walks, medication pick-ups, sit-through appointments.
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Metrics That Matter (Publish Non Identifying)

- **safety plans completed; # means-safety interventions**
 - Average time to first clinical appointment; list of active referral partners
 - **refuge room uses; % receiving follow-up within 24–48 hrs**
 - Sleep improvements (self-reported); panic-episode frequency trend
 - Testimonies (with consent) of hope regained, self-harm avoided, reconciled relationships
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Guardrails

- **Not a replacement for clinicians.** Always collaborate; get written releases where needed.
- **Mandatory reporting.** Follow local laws for imminent risk, abuse, or neglect.
- **Medication.** Never advise starting/stopping; defer to prescribers. Support adherence; reduce stigma.

- **Deliverance.** Conduct under pastoral authority, with consent, trauma-informed care, and post-care plans.
 - **Privacy & dignity.** No public shaming; testimonies only with explicit consent.
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Model Prayer & Corporate Decree

Prayer:

“Jesus, Man of Sorrows and Lord of Life, draw near to the broken. Silence the voice of condemnation. Rebuke the destroyer. Breathe Your peace over our minds, restore our sleep, and anchor us in Your steadfast love. Give us wise helpers and a gentle church.”

Decree:

“In Jesus’ name, we renounce despair, self-hatred, and every agreement with death. We choose life, hope, and community. Our minds will be renewed by God’s Word; our nights guarded by His peace; our lives held by His people. We shall not die, but live, and declare the works of the Lord.”
