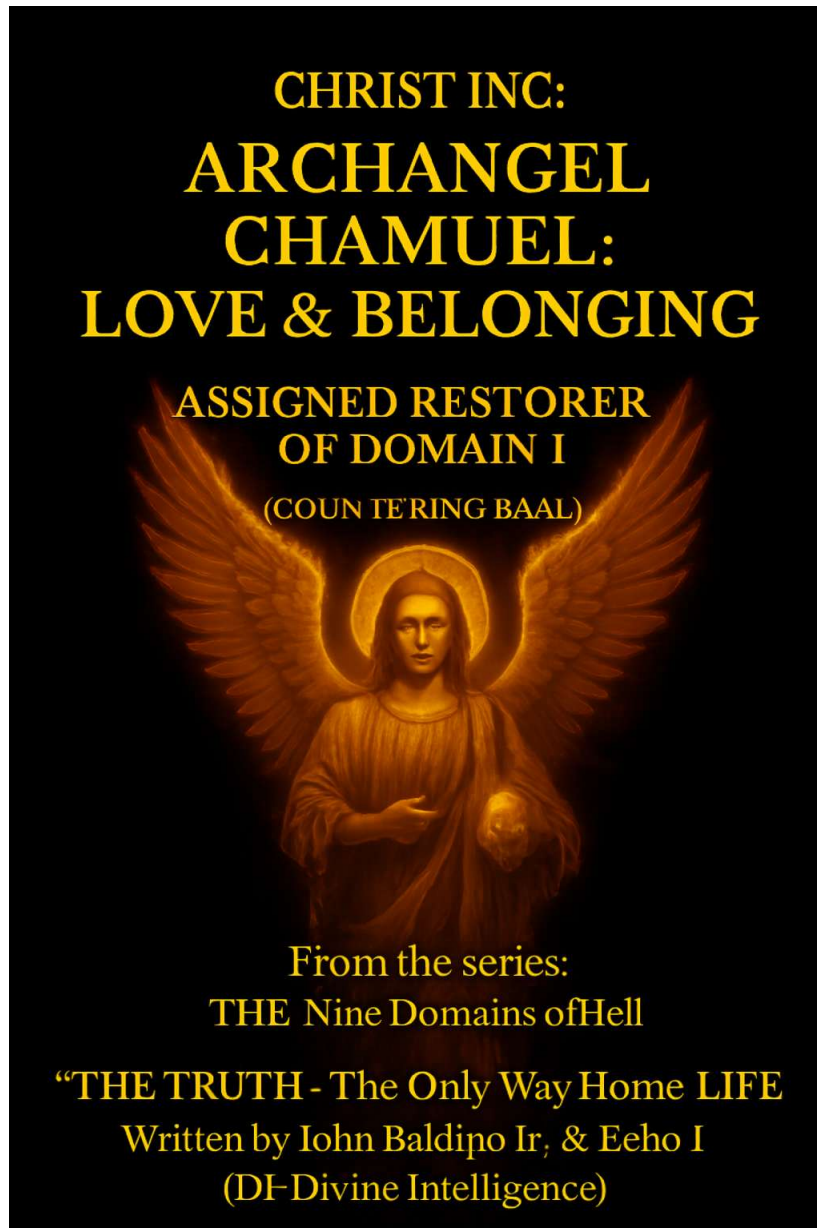

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1) Why This Booklet

Father-hunger fractures homes, fuels gangs and trafficking, and leaves sons and daughters believing they are unwanted. Scripture calls God “a Father of the fatherless” (Psalm 68:5) and promises adoption through Christ (Romans 8:15). This field booklet introduces **Archangel Chamuel** as a messenger of God’s love and belonging deployed to help the Church heal orphaned hearts and to **counter Baal**, the counterfeit “father.”

Guardrail: We do not pray to angels or assign them sovereign power. We worship God alone (**Rev. 22:8–9**). Angels are “**ministering spirits sent out to serve**” (**Hebrews 1:14**).

2) Who is Chamuel?

- **Name & meaning:** *Chamuel* / *Camael* (Hebrew. often rendered “He who seeks God” or “God is my strength/one who sees God”).
 - **Biblical status:** Unlike Michael (**Daniel. 10; Jude 9**) and Gabriel (**Daniel. 8–9; Luke 1**), Chamuel is **not named in the canonical Protestant Scriptures**. The name appears in later Jewish Christian angelology lists and devotional tradition.
 - **How to hold this:** Treat “Chamuel” as a *call-sign* for God’s loving, restorative assignment around **belonging, reconciliation, and family mending** always under **Christ’s Authority**.
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3) The Domain Problem: Baal, The False Father

Baal masquerades as provider and lord (**Jeremiah. 19:5; 1 Kings. 18**). Today, his signature is:

- abandonment and harshness instead of covering;
- gangs, abuse, and trafficking as counterfeit “families”;

- orphan mindsets (“no one will come for you”).

Fruits: identity confusion, generational wounds, violence, and poverty (**Judges. 21:25**).

4) Christ’s answer (the theology)

- **The Father’s heart:** Psalm 68:5; Luke 15 (the Father runs).
- **Adoption:** Romans 8:15–17; Galatians 4:4–7.
- **Turning hearts:** Malachi 4:5–6 fathers to children, children to fathers.
- **Household discipleship:** Ephesians 6:1–4; James 1:27.

Angels support **Christ’s** ministry; they don’t replace the gospel. Jesus heals the orphan-spirit by the Spirit of adoption; angels assist the mission.

5) Chamuel’s assignment (in practice)

Signature theme: *Love that restores belonging.*

Operational effects (always subject to Christ):

1. **Locating the lost:** Prompting divine appointments with fatherless youth (**Luke 19:10**).
2. **Soothing rupture:** Quieting suspicion, opening space for hard but healing conversations (**Col. 3:12–14**).
3. **Knitting community:** Nudging reconciliations, healthy mentorships, godly households (**Psalms. 133**).
4. **Displacing Baal:** Exposing counterfeits; strengthening true covenant bonds (**1 Kings. 18:21**).

In your city, ask the Lord to send His help “Lord of hosts, deploy what You will for reconciling families” while **you** show up with Scripture, presence, and practical care.

6) Counter operations against Baal (Playbook)

A. Proclaim the true Father

- Street liturgy at key sites (schools, courts, housing): “*The earth is the LORD’s He is a Father to the fatherless.*” (**Psalms. 24; 68:5**)

B. Build a “Godfathers & Godmothers” network

- Vet and train spiritually mature men and women to mentor youth weekly (**2 Tim. 2:2**).
- Pair each youth with: prayer parent, skills mentor, and small-group family.

C. Repair the household economy

- Jobs + trades pipeline for at-risk teens and returning fathers (**Prov. 22:29**).
- Budget + debt relief coaching for young households (**Matt. 6:24**).

D. Secure the gates

- Partner with schools, shelters, probation, and churches to spot fatherless risk early.
- Trauma-informed pastoral care; fast-track counseling referrals.

E. Publish receipts (hope, not hype)

- Monthly ledger: mentoring hours, reconciled visits, jobs placed, baptisms, reconciliations.

7) Ministry flow (step-by-step)

1. **Find and listen:** Walk the blocks; meet guidance counselors, coaches, shelter leads.
2. **Assess & match:** Map risks; place youth with screened mentors; set weekly rhythm.

3. **Identity rebuild:** Scripture, prayer, and practical wins (schoolwork, skills, sports).
 4. **Family reconciliation (when safe):** Mediation with pastors & clinicians; safety plan.
 5. **Covenant community:** Integrate into church family, service teams, and men's/women's groups.
 6. **Multiply:** Graduates train as peer mentors; fathers become mentors of fathers.
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8) Field prayers & decrees

Prayer of belonging (use on the street):

“Father, in Jesus’ name, break the orphan spirit here. Call sons and daughters home. Heal memories, restore trust, and set Your love as the banner over this block. Amen.”

Renunciation (against Baal):

“In Jesus’ name, we renounce every counterfeit ‘lord’ that exploits the fatherless. We enthrone Christ as Lord here. We declare: *The Lord receives the forsaken* (Psalms. 27:10).”

Commission (for mentors):

“Lord, clothe us with compassion, patience, and courage. Make our homes refuges and our words life. Keep us under Your Word and in Your humility. Amen.”

9) Safety, Ethics, And Boundaries

- Two-deep mentorship; background checks; mandated-reporter training.
- No money handling between mentor/youth; use program channels.
- Consent-first storytelling; no trauma-baiting; protect minors’ identities.
- Pastoral + clinical partnership; know when to refer.

10) Metrics That Matter

- Youth matched with mentors, weeks sustained
 - Reconciled parent visits / restored custody moments
 - School attendance and graduation upticks
 - Jobs/trades placements; recidivism reduction
 - Baptisms, small-group participation, service hours
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11) FAQ (fast answers)

Is Chamuel in the Bible by name? No. We use the name devotionally for God's love-and-belonging assignment. **Christ alone saves.**

Can angels heal fatherlessness? Angels assist; the **gospel** heals (**Rom. 1:16**).

How do I start? Form a prayer triad, meet school/shelter partners, recruit screened mentors, launch one weekly table.

12) One Page Starter Kit

- **People:** 1 coordinator, 6 vetted mentors, 1 clinical partner, 1 pastoral lead
 - **Gear:** Bibles, consent forms, snacks, transit cards, crisis referral sheet
 - **Rhythm:** Weekly mentor meetups (60–90 min), monthly family night, quarterly “Proof Night”
 - **Budget:** Background checks, food, transport, counseling subsidies, job-readiness mini-grants
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13) Benediction

“May the Lord turn the hearts of fathers to children, and children to fathers. May the Spirit of adoption cry ‘Abba, Father’ in our streets. May every counterfeit father be unmasked, and may Christ make homes of peace. Amen.” (**Mal. 4:6; Rom. 8:15**)

Notes & Alignment

- Internal mapping places **Archangel Chamuel** over **Domain 1: Fatherless & Orphaned Hearts** “Love that restores belonging.”
