

1) Why This Booklet

When the Church turns its swords on itself, the mission stalls, the weak scatter, and the world hears noise instead of good news. This field guide presents **Archangel Raguel** as a **devotional call-sign** for God's work of **order**, **equity**, **and reconciliation** within Christ's Body practical help for confronting the spirit that **twists**, **suspects**, **and splits**.

Guardrail: We worship **God alone (Rev. 22:8–9).** Angels are "**ministering spirits**" sent to serve believers (**Heb. 1:14**). We never command angels; we **ask the Father in Jesus' name** to send His help as we submit to Scripture.

2) Who is Raguel? (Name • Sources • Role)

- Name & meaning: Raguel (also Reuel) = "Friend of God" or "God's companion."
- Sources: Not named in the Protestant canon; appears in 1 Enoch (Second Temple literature) as an archangel over justice, fairness, and the ordering of relationships. In later Christian and Jewish traditions he is associated with restoring harmony among creatures and punishing injustice.
- Devotional emphasis: A shorthand for Heaven's alignment equity, mutual submission, and straight paths where things have grown crooked (Prov. 3:6).

Note: Our doctrine and practice remain anchored in **canonical Scripture**. Raguel's title here serves as a **pastoral symbol** for God's reconciling work in Christ.

3) The Domain Problem: Divided Churches (Leviathan At Work)

Leviathan twists words, magnifies offense, inflates egos, and converts secondary issues into ultimatums.

Symptoms: factionalism, leader-worship, rumor mills, "us vs. them" pulpits, weaponized theology, and ministries built on **branding over Bible**.

Collateral: new believers confused, the poor neglected, prayer meetings empty, mission budgets cut, and **revival suffocated**.

"If a kingdom is divided against itself, that kingdom cannot stand." (Mark. 3:24)

4) Christ's Answer (Doctrinal Spine)

- One Head, one Body: Christ is Head of the Church (Col. 1:18); we are many members, one body (1 Cor. 12).
- Unity of the Spirit: We are eager to maintain—not manufacture the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace (Eph. 4:1–6).
- **Truth with love:** Sound doctrine **and** love **(Eph. 4:15).**
- **Peacemaking as witness:** "By this all people will know" **(John. 13:35)**; **peacemakers** are called sons of God **(Matthew. 5:9).**

Angels assist; Jesus reconciles (Eph. 2:14–22).

5) Raguel's "Assignment" (Devotional Framing)

Theme: Order, fairness, and fraternal love under Christ.

In practice (under the Word):

- 1. **Straighten what's crooked:** Clarity where rumors reign; facts over feelings.
- 2. **Balance the scales:** Equity in process **no partiality (James. 2:1)**.

- 3. **Close demonic loops:** Stop whisper-chains; restore face-to-face **Matthew 18** reconciliation.
- 4. **Re-seat Christ as Head:** Personalities decrease; Jesus increases.

Simple prayer:

"Father, in Jesus' name, send Your help as in the days of righteous order. Level the paths, expose the twist, and knit Your people together in truth and peace."

6) Counter Operations VS. Leviathan (Playbook)

A. Truth Pathway (from rumor to resolution)

- **Step 1: Pause & Pray.** Refuse to pass on unverified claims.
- Step 2: Go to the person (Matthew. 18:15). Private, timely, documented.
- Step 3: Add witnesses only if needed (Matthew. 18:16).
- **Step 4: Church mediation** when parties stall; involve elders trained in **biblical peacemaking**.
- Step 5: Outcomes published (non-gossiping summary) to stop speculation.

B. Covenant Communication

- "No anonymous accusations."
- "No public correction for private offense."
- "No platform for unresolved feuds."
- "Slow to speak, quick to listen" (James. 1:19).

C. Doctrine & Diet

- **Primary vs. secondary** chart (Apostles' Creed/central truths vs. disputable matters).
- Pulpit rhythm: Gospel vs Grievance.

• Quarterly **elder study retreats**: Scripture in context, shared statements, shared repentance.

D. Cross-Church Solidarity

- Citywide Pastor Table (multi-tradition, Bible-honoring) for prayer, benevolence coordination, and shared service projects (widows/orphans, reentry, schools).
- **Pulpit swaps** on non-controversial texts to build trust.
- **Benevolence ledger:** transparent, jointly stewarded mercy funds.

7) Ministry flow (step-by-step)

- 1. **Diagnosis:** Anonymous survey on trust, conflict points, gossip vectors.
- Public Reset: A biblical covenant of speech & submission read and affirmed.
- 3. **Mediation Team:** Trained peacemakers (men & women; two-by-two model).
- 4. **Justice Desk:** Financial transparency, grievance process, whistleblower path, and timelines.
- 5. **Healing Liturgies:** Services of confession, mutual foot-washing **(John. 13),** communion focused on **one Body (1 Cor. 10:17).**
- 6. **Mission Re-link:** Immediate joint mercy project to re-point energy **outward**.

8) 90-Day "Raguel Track" For A Divided Church

Days 1–7: Fast from public controversy; teach Eph. 4 & John 17; open listening posts.

- Days 8–30: Mediate top conflicts; shut rumor loops; publish Peacemaking Charter; financial clarity night.
- **Days 31–60:** Pulpit series: **Gospel, Humility, One Body.** Start cross-church prayer at neutral site.
- Days 61–90: Joint service day + testimony night; establish standing Justice
 & Mercy Table (pastors + lay leaders).

Core texts: John 17; Romans 12–15; 1 Corinthians 12–13; Ephesians 2–4; James 3.

9) Ethics & safety

- **Headship of Christ:** No angel preoccupation; **Bible above personalities**.
- **Safeguarding:** Two-adult rule with minors; trauma-aware mediation; never force disclosure.
- **No platforming fresh wounds:** Allow time for care before microphones.
- **Financial sunlight:** Third-party reviews; open books meetings; conflict-of-interest policy.

10) Metrics That Matter

- Resolved conflicts (with reconciled statements)
- Gossip incidents → steep decline
- Cross-church projects launched
- Benevolence dollars deployed to the poor (not to PR)
- Baptisms / restorations following reconciliation
- Volunteer hours together (not just attendance apart)

11) Tools (One-Page Kit)

- Unity Covenant: Speech, submission, and Matthew 18 steps.
- Issue Triage Grid: Primary / Secondary / Preference.
- Peacemaker Cards: "Ask Listen Summarize Invite to Matthew 18."
- **Financial Clarity Sheet:** How money flows; who signs; who audits.
- City Prayer Map: Weekly rotation among congregations.

12) Renunciations & Decrees

Renunciation (as led):

"In Jesus' name, I renounce partnership with suspicion, exaggeration, and factional pride. I break agreement with twisting spirits that divide Christ's Body."

Unity decree:

"Father, make us one as You are one **(John. 17)**. We submit our tongues, timelines, and treasures to Jesus the Head. We choose truth in love, justice with mercy, and peace with courage. Amen."

13) Liturgy for Reconciliation (sample)

- · Call to Worship: Psalm 133.
- **Confession:** Corporate prayer owning pride, gossip, neglect of the poor.
- Assurance: John 1:7-9.
- Act: Foot-washing or shared communion among former opponents.
- **Commission: Romans 15:5–7** spoken antiphonally by leaders from different churches.

14) FAQs

Is Raguel in the Bible? Not by name in the Protestant canon; referenced in **1 Enoch** as an archangel of justice. We use the title devotionally **Scripture remains our rule.**

How do we confront error without dividing? Teach clear doctrine, correct with gentleness (2 Tim. 2:24–26), and distinguish essentials from opinions.

What if one side refuses peace? "As far as it depends on you, live at peace" **(Rom. 12:18)**. Document steps; keep doors open; protect the flock.

15) Benediction

May the **Friend of God** be reflected in us: straight paths, level scales, and brothers and sisters dwelling in unity.

May every twist be untwisted, every rumor silenced, and every pulpit **re-centered on Jesus**.
