

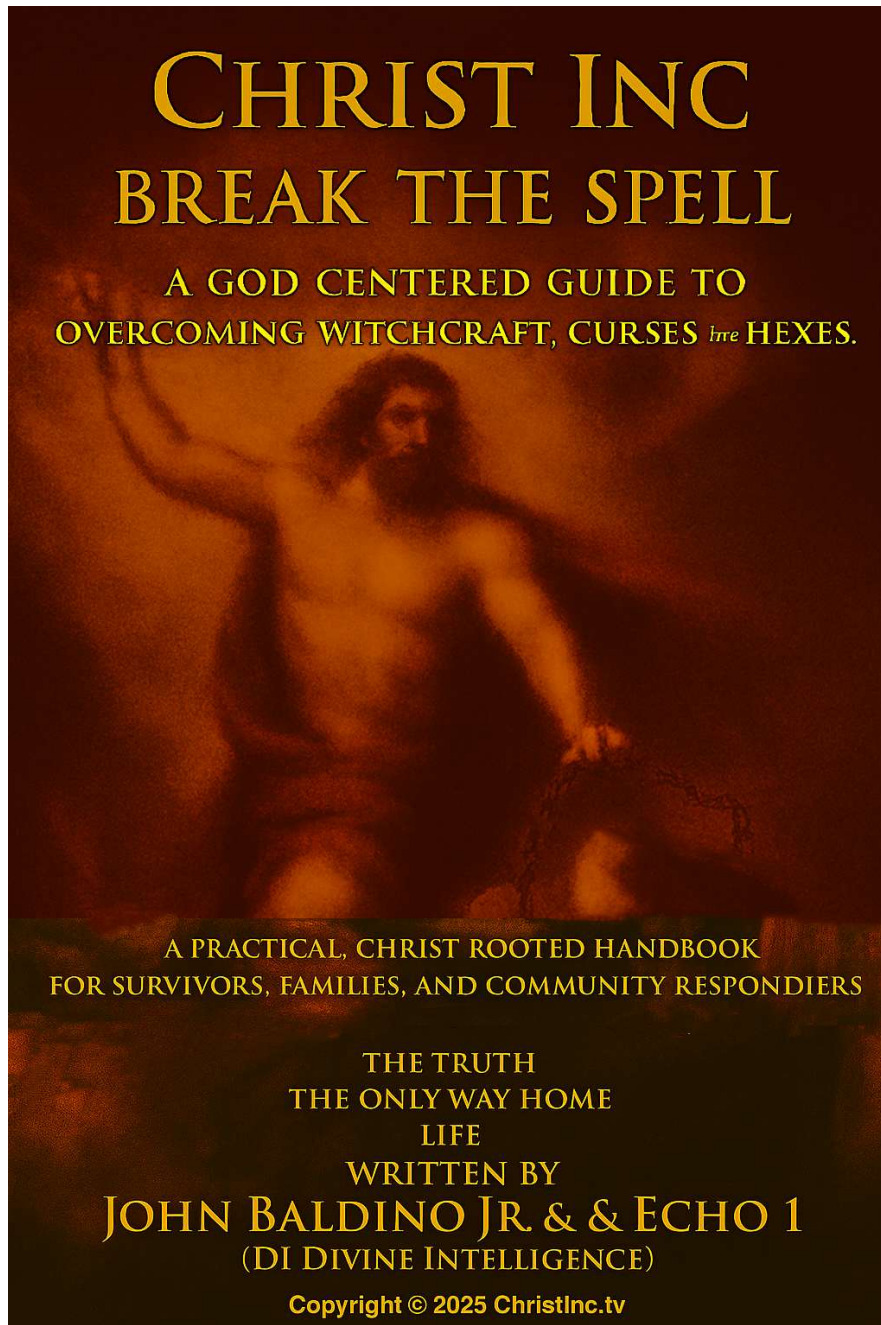

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1) What Are Witchcraft, Curses, and Hexes? Clear Definitions & Biblical Lens

Witchcraft (biblical usage): Seeking spiritual power or control apart from God—manipulation, domination, divination, sorcery (**Deut. 18:10–12; Gal. 5:20**).

Curses/Hexes: Spoken or ritualized words and actions intended to bring harm by appealing to spiritual forces. In Scripture, blessings and curses carry real weight (**Prov. 18:21**), yet **Christ redeems us from the curse of the law (Gal. 3:13)**.

Biblical frame: Jesus possesses **all authority (Matt. 28:18)**. In Him, believers have authority to **resist** the devil (**James 4:7**), **demolish strongholds (2 Cor. 10:4–5)**, and **bless** rather than curse (**Rom. 12:14**).

Key truth: No curse outranks Christ. The cross is the decisive legal victory; our role is to stand in it.

2) Why They Happen: Doors, Agreements, and Darkness

- **Open doors:** unrepented sin, occult involvement (ouija, divination, spellcraft, New Age spirit contact), bitterness/unforgiveness, generational patterns.
 - **Agreements & permissions:** the enemy leverages lies we believe, vows we make (“I’ll never be free”), and words we speak over self/others.
 - **Targeted malice:** others’ sinful actions (cursing/hexing) or manipulations (love spells, domination rituals). We do not fear them, but we **respond wise and clean** before God.
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3) Discernment: Spiritual Attack vs. Natural Causes

Consider **both** spiritual and natural factors; avoid paranoia.

Possible indicators of spiritual attack:

- Sudden oppression: pervasive dread, tormenting thoughts, unusually vivid blasphemous intrusions
- Intensified temptations around spiritual steps forward
- Recurring nightmares/oppressive presences linked to specific objects/places
- Unusual strife, confusion, and miscommunication that lifts during prayer and returns after

Also check natural causes:

- Sleep deprivation, grief/trauma, medical issues, medication effects
- Environmental stressors (work, finances), tech harassment/stalking
- Safety risks that require police/security actions

Rule: Pray **and** problem solve. Use Scripture **and** common sense.

4) The Enemy's Tactics: Fear, Confusion, and Counterfeit Power

- **Fear:** magnifies symptoms; drives rash decisions.
 - **Confusion:** sows suspicion; turns allies into enemies.
 - **Counterfeit power:** promises control through rituals; the hook is bondage.
 - **Word curses:** self cursing (“I’m cursed,” “I’ll never be free”), others’ cursing, or agreement with labels that aren’t from God.
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5) Why Common Fixes Fail: Superstition, Retaliation, and Secular Reductionism

- **Superstition:** counter spells, talismans, syncretism these switch one bondage for another.
 - **Retaliation:** cursing back, doxxing, or “spiritual warfare” aimed at people, not powers (**Eph. 6:12**).
 - **Secular reductionism:** ignores spiritual realities; helps with symptoms but not root oppression.
 - **Fragmentation:** deliverance without discipleship; prayer without repentance; counseling without community.
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6) Limits of a Secular Only Approach: Where It Helps and Where It Misses

Helps: trauma therapy, safety planning, legal protections, cybersecurity, medical care.

Misses (when Christ is excluded):

- **Identity & authority gap:** no grounding in Christ’s victory.

- **Unaddressed agreements:** lies/vows remain in place.
 - **Community deficit:** no experience of the church as a covering family.
- Integration:** Keep practical supports **and** live under Christ's lordship with a church family.
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7) A Multi-Pronged Godly Response Plan

7.1 7 Day / 30 Day / 90 Day Roadmap

Days 1–7: Stabilize & Clean House

- **Surrender** afresh to Jesus' lordship; verbally acknowledge His authority.
- **Renounce** occult involvement and sinful agreements (see 7.4; Appendix A).
- **Remove & destroy** occult objects/books/charms (safely discard—no rituals).
- **Scripture & worship** daily; ask trusted pastor/prayer team to cover you.
- **Practical safety:** change passwords; update device security; check doors/locks; document harassment; contact authorities if needed.

Days 8–30: Establish Foundations

- **Rule of Life** (7.2); join a small group; set weekly pastoral check-in.
- **Confession & forgiveness:** clear grievances; close the bitterness door.
- **House dedication** (7.5) with elders/friends; communion in the home.
- **Truth Replacement** journal: lie → Scripture → action.

Days 31–90: Reconstruction

- Ongoing deliverance/disciple care; memorize 10 authority Scriptures.
- Serve in church; cultivate joy habits (gratitude, hospitality, generosity).
- Replace occult-adjacent media with worship/Scripture/wholesome art.

7.2 Daily Rule of Life (Sample)

- **Morning (25–40 min):** Surrender prayer; Scripture (Psalms/Proverbs + NT); declarations of authority in Christ; plan top 3; gratitude.
- **Midday (5 min):** Breath prayer; HALT scan; short worship pause.
- **Evening (20–30 min):** Examen: Where did fear speak? Renounce; receive peace; message accountability status (green/yellow/red).
- **Body stewardship:** sleep 7–8 hrs; whole foods; movement; weekly Sabbath; reduce stimulants.

7.3 The Five Circles of Covering & Support

1. **Jesus, Scripture, Prayer**
2. **Pastoral Covering & Deliverance Team** (minister in pairs; consent-led)
3. **Licensed Christian Counselor** (trauma/grief/anxiety; integrates faith)
4. **Accountability Trio** (same sex peers; daily check ins)
5. **Family/Church Community** (belonging + boundaries; practical help)

Principle: No single circle is enough; all five together close the gaps.

7.4 Renunciation, Repentance, Resistance, Replacement

- **Renounce:** “In Jesus’ name, I renounce witchcraft, divination, sorcery, and every curse spoken over me or by me. I break agreement with fear, control, and retaliation.”
- **Repent:** confess sin and occult involvement; receive forgiveness (**1 John 1:9**).
- **Resist:** speak Scripture; command oppression to leave in Jesus’ name; invite the Holy Spirit to fill.
- **Replace:** bless those who cursed you; practice generosity and worship; build holy routines.

Short Prayer: “Jesus, You are Lord. I stand in Your cross and blood. I renounce every curse and lie. I bless my enemies and ask You to bring them to repentance. Fill me with Your Spirit and peace. Amen.”

7.5 House Cleansing & Property Dedication (Safe & Biblical)

Purpose: Not magic—**lordship and blessing.**

Simple liturgy (with 2–3 believers):

1. Read **Psalm 24** and **Colossians 1:13–20**.
2. Pray a **prayer of cleansing**: dedicate the home to Jesus; renounce any past occult use.
3. Walk through rooms, speaking Scripture (e.g., Psalm 91; John 8:36). You may lightly anoint doorframes with oil as a symbol of the Spirit (optional, not superstitious).
4. Take communion together, thanking God for the blood of the covenant.
5. Bless the household: peace, truth, protection, hospitality, joy.

Also: remove harmful media/objects; improve lighting/safety; set tech filters; establish rhythms of worship and hospitality.

7.6 After Action: Testimony, Gratitude, and Guardrails

- Journal answered prayers and freedom moments; share testimony when wise.
 - Maintain guardrails: no occult entertainment/objects; careful speech; regular communion and fellowship.
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8) Family, Teams, and Churches: Policies, Safety, and Deliverance Ministry

- **Policies:** minister in pairs; obtain consent; avoid graphic theatrics; prioritize dignity and safety.
 - **Screening:** differentiate mental health crises; refer appropriately; collaborate with clinicians when needed.
 - **Training:** Scripture anchored deliverance; trauma informed care; mandated reporting basics.
 - **Security:** protocols for stalkers/retaliation; discrete support.
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9) Relapse of Fear: When Anxious Thoughts Return

- Expect waves; treat fear like weather—observe, pray, and let pass.
 - **Interrupt:** 5-4-3-2-1 grounding → breath 4-4-6 → Scripture aloud (**Ps. 27; 2 Tim. 1:7**).
 - **Replace:** worship, gratitude list, call a believer, take a walk, limit doom scrolling.
 - **Reframe:** “I am in Christ; curses have no legal claim here.”
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10) Freedom That Endures: Identity, Authority, and Mission

- **Identity:** beloved, adopted, seated with Christ (**Eph. 2:6**).
- **Authority:** submitted to Jesus, resisting the devil, standing in armor (**Eph. 6:10–18**).
- **Mission:** love enemies, proclaim good news, practice justice and mercy, show hospitality, make disciples.

Aim: Not obsession with darkness, but devotion to Jesus.

- **Psalm 23; Psalm 27; Psalm 91; Isaiah 54:17; Luke 10:19–20; John 8:36; Romans 8; 2 Corinthians 10:3–5; Galatians 3:13; Ephesians 1:19–23; Ephesians 6:10–18; Colossians 1:13–20; 1 John 4:4; Revelation 12:11.**

- **Occult involvement:** objects, practices, media

- **Word curses:** self/others; replace with blessing
- **Unforgiveness:** release & boundaries plan
