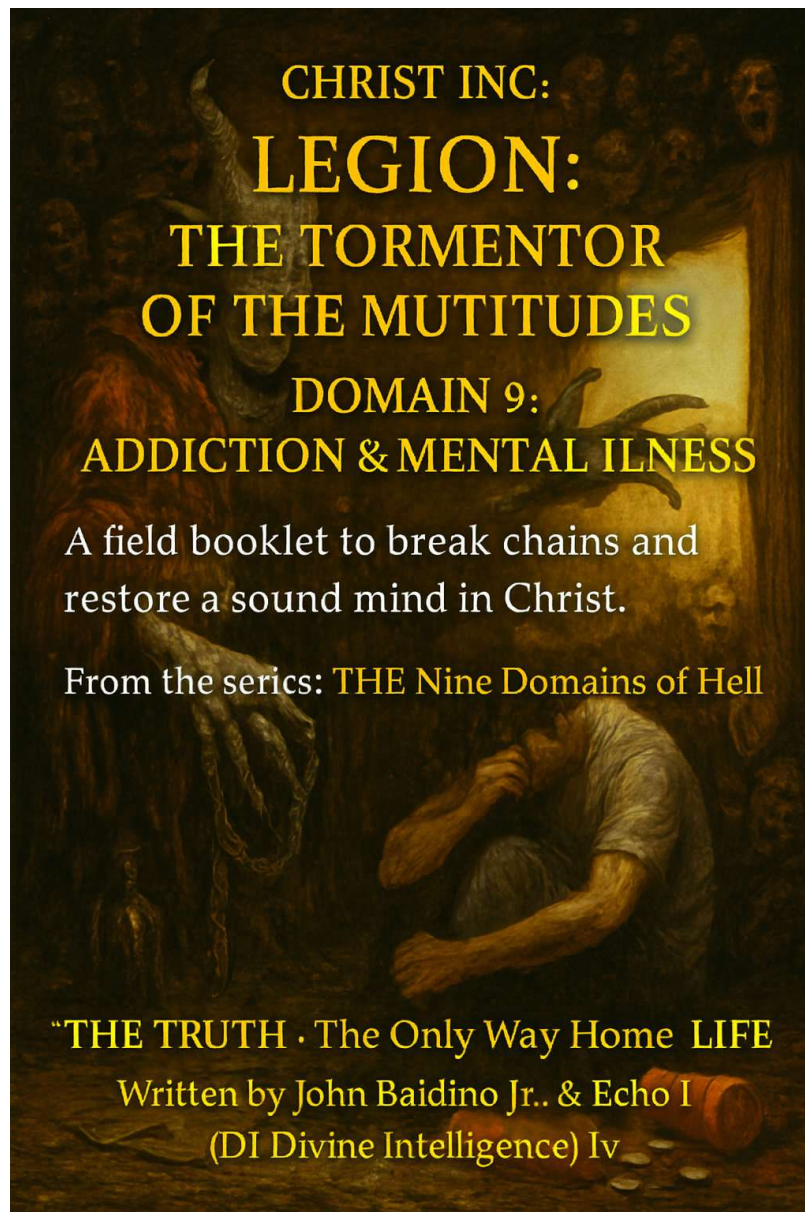

Aim

Pair Spirit-led deliverance with wise, dignified care to see captives “clothed and in their right mind” (**Mk 5:15**).

1) The Problem When One Voice Becomes Many

Addiction stacks on trauma, anxiety, depression, PTSD, psychosis.

What promised relief becomes a prison:

- Sleep vanishes; paranoia rises; relationships fracture.
- Pills and powders become **chains**; cravings drown out conscience.
- Shame buries identity beneath labels: “addict,” “crazy,” “lost cause.”

“The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy” **John 10:10**

2) Biblical Frame “My name is Legion”

Mark 5: a man isolated, self-harming, uncontrollable **one encounter** with Jesus and he sits **clothed and in his right mind**.

Romans 12:2: the mind is **renewed**.

2 Timothy 1:7: not fear, but **power, love, and a sound mind**.

Truth: Jesus is stronger than the swarm. Deliverance is realm and so is steady, wise care.

3) The Strategy of Legion

- **Multiply pain:** trauma → triggers → substances → deeper bondage.
 - **Claim territory:** rehearsed lies (“you can’t change”) become strongholds.
 - **Isolate:** cut off help; keep battles underground.
 - **Rename:** weaponize labels to bury sonship/daughterhood in Christ.
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4) The Fallout A Hospital Without Discharge

- Revolving-door ER visits and psych holds.
 - Overdoses, suicide attempts, legal crises, debt.
 - Families exhausted; trust shattered; hope thin.
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5) Gospel Countermove Christ Breaks Every Chain

Jesus liberates the person, not just the habit.

Four pillars:

1. **Deliverance:** repent, renounce, evict the intruders in Jesus’ name.
2. **Discipleship:** daily Word, worship, and new habits.
3. **Dignified Clinical Care:** trauma-informed counseling; meds when appropriate.
4. **Community:** sponsors, mentors, small groups, work/rest rhythms.

Goal: not only sobriety but **sonship** freedom with a renewed mind and restored purpose.

6) Practical Restoration Steps (Immediate → Ongoing)

A) First 72 Hours Stabilize & Secure

- **Safety:** remove lethal means; write a **crisis plan** (who to call, where to go).
- **Detox:** if at risk, seek **medically supervised** detox.
- **Covering:** alert a pastor/mentor + one trusted family member.
- **Sleep & hydration:** restore basics; light, protein, water.

B) Weeks 1–4 Break & Build

- **Repent & Renounce:** out loud, specific (substance, rituals, suppliers).
- **Deliverance prayer** with accountable leaders (no lone-rangers).
- **Counseling:** trauma-informed clinician; schedule weekly.
- **Meetings:** Christ-centered recovery group (2–3×/week).
- **Scripture plan:** AM **Psalm/Proverbs**; PM **Gospels & Romans 6–8**.
- **Environmental sweep:** dispose of stashes, paraphernalia; change routes; block contacts.

C) Months 2–3 Renew & Root

- **Work & Rhythm:** steady job/volunteer; sleep (same hours); exercise/walks.

- **Boundaries:** cash controls, drug tests if helpful, phone filters, curfew.
 - **Relapse map:** list triggers → scripture/call/action; rehearse responses.
 - **Service:** weekly act of mercy (shelter, meal train, church setup).
 - **Family repair:** start amends where safe; invite a mediator when needed.
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7) A 90 Day Freedom Plan (at a glance)

- **Daily:** Word (20m), prayer (10m), movement (20m), check-in text to sponsor.
 - **Weekly:** small group, counseling, church, one service slot, Sabbath half-day.
 - **Monthly:** testimony update (1 page), financial review, joy day (healthy celebration).
 - **Milestones:** 30/60/90 days communion + anointing; share what God renewed.
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8) Church & Team Toolkit

Build a triage church (refuge, not performance):

- **Rooms of Refuge:** quiet spaces with trained teams (pastor + clinician + peer mentor + intercessor).
- **Clear pathways:** intake form → immediate plan → follow-up within 24 hrs.
- **Partnerships:** vetted clinics, detox centers, housing; sliding-scale counseling.

- **Training:** ushers/youth leads spot warning signs; leaders learn deescalation and boundaries.
- **Metrics that matter:** people disciplined post-crisis, reunified families, stable housing/jobs, months of sobriety not just headcounts.

Guardrails: background checks, two by two ministry, no cash handling by vulnerable members, mandated-reporting compliance.

9) Prayers & Decrees

Renunciation (read aloud):

“In the name of Jesus Christ, I renounce addiction, despair, and every spirit that rode in on trauma, rejection, and fear. I break agreement with the lies that I am an addict and a lost cause. I receive the Spirit of power, love, and a sound mind. Jesus, you are Lord over my body, brain, and future. Amen.”

House cleansing: Psalm 24; dedicate each room; worship in the home.

Armor (Eph 6): truth, righteousness, peace, faith, salvation, Word **daily**.

10) Scriptures for Renewal

- **Identity & mind:** 2 Tim 1:7; Rom 8; Eph 1–2
- **Freedom & sonship:** Jn 8:36; Gal 5:1; Rom 6
- **Strength in weakness:** Ps 18; Ps 40; 2 Cor 12:9–10
- **Hope & comfort:** Ps 34:18; Ps 147:3; Lam 3:22–24
- **Authority:** Lk 10:19; Col 1:13–14

11) Testimonies From Chains to Champions

- Former heroin users now preach in the alleys they once haunted.
- Bipolar survivors serve as intercessors and peer mentors.
- Ex-patients lead Christ-centered recovery houses **freedom is a Person**.

“They come to Jesus, and see him that was possessed with the devil, and had the legion, sitting, and clothed, and in his right mind.” Mark 5:15 (KJV)

12) Mission Confront Legion, Restore the Image

- Build recovery that is **biblical, clinical, and communal**.
- Make churches **triage centers** swift care, steady discipleship.
- Train believers to minister to the **whole person**: spirit, soul, body.
- Proclaim: **new name, right mind, real future** in Jesus Christ.
