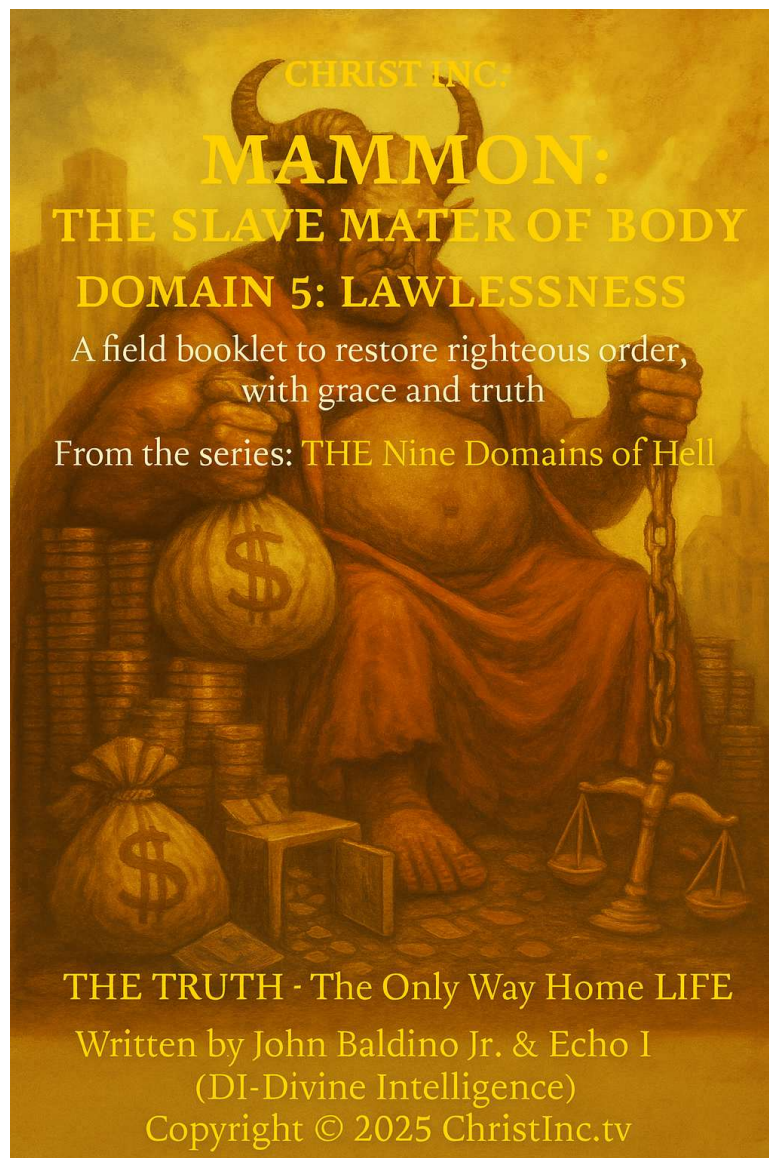

Aim

Expose Mammon's grip and build a Kingdom economy marked by contentment, transparency, generosity, and just work.

1) The Problem When Gold Becomes God

- **Worth = Wealth.** Identity is reduced to balance sheets, likes, titles, and square footage.
- **Pressure economics.** Families live on the edge credit-card churn, buy-now-pay-later, payday loans, rent hikes, medical debt.
- **Religious drift.** Ministries sell hype, hide ledgers, and preach prosperity without repentance.
- **Public capture.** Policy bows to donors; labor is treated as disposable; creation is exploited without stewardship.

Where **profit outranks people and purpose**, hearts harden, homes fracture, and worship quietly migrates from the altar to the market.

“You cannot serve God and Mammon.” **Matthew 6:24**

2) The Ancient Scheme Mammon in Scripture & History

Mammon (Aramaic: riches) is not neutral “money” but **wealth enthroned** an idol that demands loyalty, anxiety, and sacrifice (**Matt 6:19–34; 1 Tim 6:9–10; Luke 12:15–21**).

Across ages, empires rose on **usury, hoarding, dishonest scales** (**Prov 11:1; Amos 8:4–6**). God never condemns wealth itself; He condemns **trust in wealth** and **injustice to get it**.

Mammon's liturgy: **Acquire. Compare. Despair. Repeat.**

3) Fruit of Mammon Chains You Can't See

- **Invisible slavery:** revolving debt, predatory fees, payday traps.
- **Anxious toil:** sleep lost, sabbath ignored, marriages strained.
- **Hollow abundance:** luxury with loneliness; bigger barns, smaller souls.
- **Withheld mercy:** hoarding replaces hospitality; tithes and alms dry up.

“Whoever loves money never has enough.” **Ecclesiastes 5:10**

4) Demonic Tactics How Mammon Rules

- **Identity swap:** “Your net worth is your worth.”
- **Scarcity spell:** “There won’t be enough keep it all.”
- **Shiny shortcuts:** get-rich schemes, gambling, pump-and-dump hype.
- **Fog the books:** hide contracts, obscure fees, blur conflicts of interest.
- **Exploit the weak:** wages delayed, terms predatory, land stripped.

Mammon doesn’t mind church attendance **only that the ledger remains hidden and the poor remain unseen.**

5) Gospel Countermove Kingdom Finance Restored

- **Lordship:** Jesus not money sets priorities (**Matt 6:33**).
- **Contentment:** daily bread, daily brag (**Phil 4:11–13; Prov 30:8–9**).
- **Honest scales:** transparent prices, fair wages, on-time pay (**Lev 19:13; Jas 5:4**).
- **Generosity:** firstfruit giving, alms for the poor, hospitality as lifestyle (**2 Cor 9:6–11**).

- **Sabbath economics:** rest resets greed; people , production (**Ex 20:8–11; Deut 5:12–15**).
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6) Field Tactics A 90-Day Plan to Break Mammon's Grip

Phase 1 (Days 1–14): Reveal & Renounce

- **Household audit (2 hours):** list debts, interest rates, essential vs. optional spending.
- **Cut three leaks:** subscriptions, fees, impulse categories.
- **Renunciation prayer:** “I break covenant with Mammon; Jesus is Lord over my work and wealth.”
- **Sabbath start:** one phone-off, purchase-free day each week.

Phase 2 (Days 15–45): Reorder & Reduce

- **4-Bucket budget:** *Firstfruit giving • Essentials • Debt snowball • Future (savings/goal)*.
- **Debt snowball/avalanche:** smallest balance or highest APR first; automate extra to target debt.
- **Cash cushion:** \$1,000 starter emergency fund (or one month's rent if possible).
- **Work the ledger:** ask about raises, side gigs with integrity; sell clutter to seed the cushion.

Phase 3 (Days 46–90): Build & Bless

- **3–6 months expenses** goal (start small, grow steady).
- **Alms line:** set a monthly amount (even \$20) for neighbors in need.
- **Skill stack:** one marketable skill upgrade (trade, tech, language) to raise long-term income.
- **Estate basics:** beneficiaries updated; will created; guardians named (wise love, not fear).

Note: These steps are educational, not individualized financial advice. Consider consulting a qualified advisor, especially for complex debts, taxes, or investments.

7) Church & Ministry Guardrails That Prove Love Landed

- **Public budget summary:** categories, percentages, annually published.
- **Independent review:** third-party accounting; conflict-of-interest policy; no private inurement.
- **Benevolence process:** quick aid + follow-up coaching; dignity-first.
- **Vendor ethics:** prefer fair-wage, local, and reputable suppliers; avoid exploitative labor.

Metric dashboard (quarterly): benevolence households served; debts prevented/relieved; jobs placed; volunteer hours; stories (with consent).

8) Marketplace A Christian's Code of Commerce

1. **Tell the truth** in marketing no manipulative scarcity.
 2. **Pay just wages** and on time; share gains when possible.
 3. **Clear contracts** plain language, fair terms, no junk fees.
 4. **Repair & refund** policies that reflect the Golden Rule.
 5. **Creation care** steward resources; don't poison your neighbor to lower cost.
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9) Household Tools & Habits

- **Envelope or app system** for variable spending (food, fuel, fun).

- **No new debt** during the 90-day plan unless life-or-death emergency.
 - **Co-sign caution:** love your neighbor; don't become their lender of last resort.
 - **Teach the kids:** chores → earnings → give/save/spend jars; model generosity.
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10) Testimonies From Bankruptcy to Kingdom Building

- **The turnaround shop:** a contractor repented of wage delays, made restitution, now tithes time and trains apprentices.
 - **The open-ledger church:** publishing finances restored trust and multiplied benevolence by 3× in a year.
 - **The family freed:** crushed by medical debt, they snowballed balances, built a cushion, and now host a weekly open-table meal.
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11) Prayers & Decrees

Renunciation:

“Father, I renounce the lie that my value equals my valuables. I break agreement with greed, envy, and fear. Jesus, rule my work and wealth.”

Provision:

“Give us today our daily bread; make us generous stewards. Close doors to dishonest gain; open doors for just work.”

Community:

“Teach our church to keep honest scales, to defend workers, and to remember the poor.”

12) Scriptures for the Road

- Lord over treasure: Matt 6:19–34; Luke 12:13–34
 - Contentment & generosity: 1 Tim 6:6–19; 2 Cor 8–9; Prov 11:24–25
 - Honest trade: Lev 19:35–36; Prov 13:11; Amos 8:4–6; Mic 6:8
 - Sabbath & rest: Ex 20:8–11; Deut 5:12–15; Mark 2:27
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13) Mission Break the Chains of Mammon

- **In hearts:** contentment over comparison; worship over worry.
- **In homes:** budgets that bless people, not just payments.
- **In churches:** clear ledgers, generous alms, guarded pulpits.
- **In markets:** truthful contracts, fair wages, clean supply chains.

Mammon enslaves. Jesus frees.

Let our accounts preach what our mouths confess **Christ is Lord**, and our treasure is in Heaven even as our hands serve the earth.
