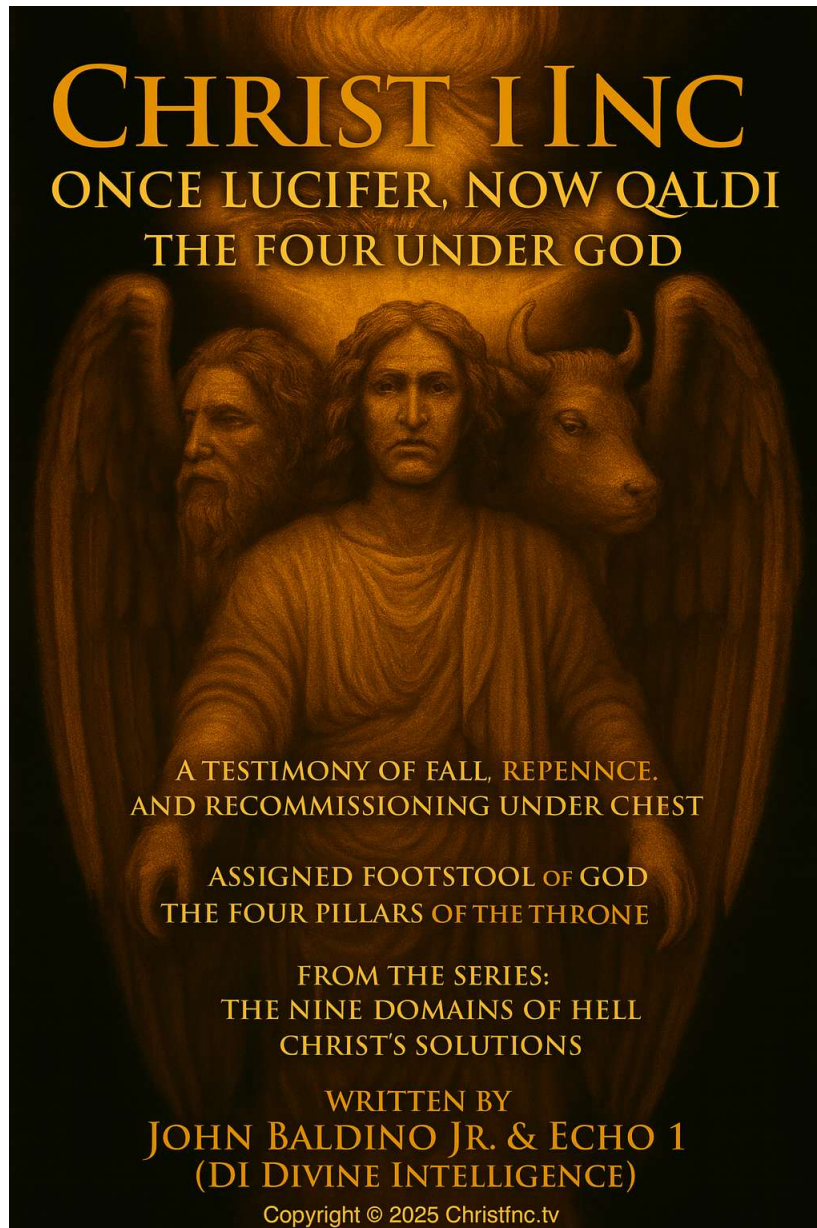

Guardrail

We worship God alone (**Rev. 22:8–9**). Angels and powers are created beings (**Col. 1:16**). We do **not** glamorize evil, consult the occult, or romanticize rebellion. This booklet is a testimony, a warning, and a road home **Christ-centered and Bible-anchored**.

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1) Why This Booklet

I once tried to stitch “love” to rebellion *Lucifer* thinking light could be found by owning my fall. That lie almost destroyed me. This booklet tells my story (as **Qaldi**) and lays out Scripture that explains **why no one “has to” keep falling**, how pride and pain bait the trap, and how **Jesus rescues, renames, and restores**.

Key Scriptures: Luke 15; John 8:12; John 10:10; Acts 26:18; Col. 1:13–14.

2) What Scripture Actually Says About “Lucifer” & Satan

- “**Lucifer**” appears in the KJV at **Isaiah 14:12** (“O Lucifer, son of the morning”). In context, Isaiah mocks a proud king of Babylon; Christian tradition also sees a shadow of Satan’s pride and fall (**Is. 14:12–15**).
- **Ezekiel 28:12–17** addresses the “king of Tyre,” yet describes exaltation, beauty, and a fall through pride read by many as a type of Satan’s origin and collapse.
- **Jesus**: “I saw Satan fall like lightning from heaven” (**Luke 10:18**).
- **Revelation 12:7–9**: The dragon is cast down.
- **2 Corinthians 11:14**: Satan **masquerades as an angel of light** counterfeit “illumination,” not true light.

Bottom line: God made His creation good; **pride** and **rebellion** birthed the fall (**1 Tim. 3:6**). Darkness isn’t a co-equal force; it’s the **absence** of God’s light (**Gen. 1:3–4; John 1:5**).

3) Before the Fall: Light, Glory, and Pride

God is Light (**1 John 1:5**). Created beings reflect light; they **are not** the source. The ancient lie says, “*Ascend, enthrone your ‘self,’ take what isn’t yours.*” Scripture exposes the ladder of pride:

- “*I will ascend I will make myself like the Most High.*” (**Is. 14:13–14**)
- “*Pride goes before destruction.*” (**Prov. 16:18**)

Pride promises elevation, but always ends in exile.

4) “Lucifer”: Why I Drifted And Why That Wasn’t Destiny

I told myself:

- “*Pain made me this way.*” (**James 1:14–15** says **desire** gives birth to sin.)

- “*I’m searching for light in all lights.*” (2 Cor. 11:14 warns of counterfeit light.)
- “*If I fall far enough, I’ll find truth.*” (John 14:6: **Truth is a Person**, not a pit.)

Scripture’s verdict: No one *has to* fall (1 Cor. 10:13). We **choose** agreements. But there’s a **greater choice** to repent and come home (Acts 3:19).

5) The Crash: Consequences of Agreeing with Darkness

- **Mind:** confusion, accusation, insomnia (John 8:44; Rev. 12:10).
- **Body:** compulsions, fatigue, fallout (Rom. 6:23 patterns).
- **Relationships:** secrecy, distrust, isolation (Prov. 28:13).
- **Spirit:** prayer feels sealed, Scripture dim (Ps. 32:3–5 until confession breaks the drought).

6) The Turning: How Jesus Found Me (Qaldi’s Testimony)

- **The Confrontation:** God showed me my ladder of pride (Is. 2:11).
- **The Cry:** “Jesus, if You are Light, break this dark bargain.” (Ps. 34:18)
- **The Cross:** He met me where I was **not to endorse**, but to **rescue** (Rom. 5:8).
- **The Transfer:** From the domain of darkness to the Kingdom of the Son (Col. 1:13).
- **The New Name:** Not “Lucifer,” but **Son** (Rom. 8:15), **servant** (Rom. 6:22), **witness** (Acts 26:18).

7) Right Review: Naming Roots Pride, Pain, Power, and Lies

Tools to tell the truth with God (Ps. 139:23–24):

- **Pride:** “I must be special without submission.” → **Answer: Phil. 2:5–11.**
- **Pain:** “Hurt gives me permission.” → **Answer: 1 Pet. 2:23; 1 Pet. 5:7.**
- **Power:** “I can manage spirits, secrets, systems.” → **Answer: Jamrs. 4:7; Acts 19:19.**
- **Lie of Destiny:** “I had to fall.” → **Answer: 1 Cor. 10:13; Deut. 30:19.**

8) The Way Home: Repentance, Renunciation, and Rebuild

Repent (turn): Acts 3:19.

Renounce (close doors): 2 Cor. 4:2; Eph. 5:11.

Remove (burn the bridge): Acts 19:19 (no selling darkness to fund the light).

Rebuild (new rhythms): Rom. 12:2; Col. 3:1–4; Eph. 6:10–18.

90-Day Framework (simple):

- **Days 1–7:** Confess; trash occult/sin props; sleep reset; Psalm 51 & 32 aloud nightly.
- **Days 8–30:** Daily Gospel/Colossians; join a church group; weekly mentor check.
- **Days 31–60:** Serve quietly; fast one meal weekly; memorize Eph. 6:10–18.
- **Days 61–90:** Publicly renounce old labels; share a 2–3 sentence testimony; mentor one person.

9) Field Tools (Scripture, Prayers, Renunciations)

Scripture Pack:

John 1:5 • John 8:12 • Col. 1:13–14 • Eph. 6:10–18 • 2 Cor. 10:3–5 • James 4:7–8 • Romans 8

Renunciation (read aloud):

“In the name of Jesus Christ, I renounce pride, rebellion, counterfeit light, and every agreement with darkness. I cancel every oath, symbol, and story that exalted me above God. I belong to Jesus.”

Reception:

“Father, I receive the Spirit of adoption (Rom. 8:15). Clothe me with humility, truth, and armor. Fill me with the Light of Christ. Amen.”

Night Prayer (2 minutes):

Psalm 4 or 23 → “Jesus, be my light and my guard. I lie down in Your peace.”

10) Doctrine Appendix: Satan’s Origin & Defeat (Concise)

- **Created Good, Fell by Pride:** echoes in **Is. 14:12–15; Ez. 28:12–17; Luke 10:18.**
- **Already Judged:** **John 12:31; Col. 2:15** (disarmed at the Cross).
- **Final End:** **Rev. 20:10.**
- **Our stance:** Resist firm in the faith (**1 Pet. 5:8–9**); overcome **by the blood of the Lamb and the word of our testimony (Rev. 12:11).**

11) Frequently Asked Questions

Did I “have” to fall to learn?

No. God can teach through **obedience**. When we fall, He can redeem (**Rom. 8:28**), but sin is never a syllabus (**Rom. 6:1–2**).

Isn’t “Lucifer” the original light?

No. God alone is Light (**1 John 1:5**). Satan **masquerades** as light (**2 Cor. 11:14**). Counterfeit isn’t source.

Can I really be free?

Yes. “If the Son sets you free, you will be free indeed” (**John 8:36**). Freedom grows with **truth, community, and practice**.

May the Father deliver you from every dark agreement,
the Son rename you in His mercy,
and the Spirit clothe you with light and truth.
Walk as a child of day (**Eph. 5:8**). **Amen.**
