

Preamble. Why Creation groans for truth, not excuses

Romans 8:22 says "The whole creation groans as in the pains of childbirth." Pollution is not just a technical issue. It is spiritual. When rivers are poisoned, when air is heavy with smog, when seas are fouled by waste — people suffer, animals suffer, and the glory of God's creation is scarred. Excuses are easy, but intercession and honest advocacy are harder. This booklet seeks to unmask deception and equip believers to pray, act, and demand clean stewardship.

Prologue. The prayer that opened my eyes

I once stood by a river after a factory spill. Fish floated belly up. The smell burned the air. I prayed, "Lord, heal this water." But I felt God reply: "I heal through your

hands, your voice, your witness." From that moment, I learned that intercession without advocacy is incomplete. God calls us to cry out in prayer **and** to speak truth in the gates.

Chapter 1. Industrial Greenwash and Empty Pledges Plays

- Corporations promise "net zero" but count offsets, not real cuts.
- PR campaigns about "eco-packaging" while production pollution climbs.
- International pledges signed, but deadlines quietly missed.

Defenses

- Ask for audited emission reports, not slogans.
- Support watchdog groups that track actual pollutants.
- Demand measurable results: ppm reduced, rivers restored, air cleared.

Chapter 2. Pollution Burdens on the Poor

Plays

- Toxic waste dumps near low-income neighborhoods.
- Developing nations used as dumping grounds for electronic and plastic waste.
- Communities without lawyers or lobbyists left with poisoned water.

Defenses

- Stand with frontline communities.
- Push for environmental justice policies that protect the least powerful.
- Support ministries that combine relief with advocacy.

Chapter 3. Plastic, Poison, and the Politics of Delay Plays

- "Studies" funded by polluters that stall regulation.
- Politicians who take donations to water down clean air and water rules.
- Token bans on straws while tons of packaging escape reform.

Defenses

- Follow the money behind policies.
- Support bans and redesigns that attack the biggest waste streams.
- Educate youth to trace every product's waste footprint.

Chapter 4. Farm, Factory, and Fossil Fuel Fog Plays

- Farm runoff spreads nitrates and dead zones, but lobbyists block reform.
- Coal plants and mines leak mercury into rivers and seas.
- Factories relocate to countries with weaker laws to keep polluting.

Defenses

- Demand farm-to-market transparency about fertilizers and waste.
- Track mercury and heavy metals back to their sources.
- Support clean energy transitions with community safeguards.

Chapter 5. Intercession: Standing in the Gap

- Prayer walks at polluted rivers, factories, and landfills.
- Fasting for environmental justice, asking God to expose lies.
